
Sandestin Excursion Ideas

Beaches & Parks

- Beach at Hilton Sandestin Beach Golf Resort & Spa:
 - The beach at Hilton Sandestin Beach Golf Resort & Spa is part of a stretch of coastline in South Walton that is considered one of the world's most beautiful. Hilton Sandestin Beach is the largest full-service beachfront resort on Northwest Florida's Gulf Coast. Here, our guests can have their toes in the sand or the surf within minutes of leaving their rooms and suites. They can watch beach sunsets from their private balconies, as each guest room and suite offers full or partial Gulf views. Our <u>Barefoot's Beachside Bar & Grill</u> and the Sandbar are both beachfront, so our guests can dine and drink while gazing out at the Gulf. We can provide anything

you might need for a great beach day – beach chairs, umbrellas, towels and sunscreen. <u>Beach setup may be reserved online</u>. We also offer kayaks, stand-up paddle boards, beach volleyball and beach bonfires.

• Grayton Beach State Park:

Grayton Beach consistently ranks among the most beautiful and pristine beaches in the United States. Western Lake offers fishing and paddling, and those who want to explore on foot have 4 miles of trails to traverse through a coastal forest where scrub oaks and magnolias are bent and twisted by salt winds.

An overnight excursion yields its own unique experience with a stay in one of the well outfitted cabins or a more rustic accommodation at one of Grayton's cozy campgrounds. At nearly 2,000 acres, Grayton Beach State Park is more than a backdrop for golden sunrises and silver moonlit evenings.

• Topsail Hill Preserve State Park:

Two of the area's dune lakes – Morris Lake and Campbell Lake – can be found just a few miles away from the Hilton Sandestin Beach at Topsail Hill Preserve State Park. Those same white quartz dunes are responsible for a rare coastal ecosystem of freshwater dune lakes that teem with aquatic wildlife. Walkers will pass through old-growth pine forests, sandy scrubland, dunes and wetlands, where they may see some of the 13 imperiled species that find refuge here. Topsail Hill offers 3 miles of pristine beaches and is a bird-watching and hiking paradise.

Fishing

Located about 10 miles away from Hilton Sandestin Beach Golf Resort & Spa — Destin, Florida is known to many as the "luckiest fishing village in the world." Naturally, fishing is a favorite Destin activity among locals and visitors to the area. From deep sea fishing in Destin to near-shore excursions, the area's proximity to the East Pass and the Gulf of Mexico make it an ideal location to find red snapper, grouper, triggerfish and amberjack.



- Baytowne Marina Guests at Hilton Sandestin Beach can take the complimentary resort shuttle to the nearby <u>Baytowne Marina</u>, located on the Choctawhatchee Bay. There, you can arrange half-day, full-day and overnight fishing charters on one of the marina's two boats Ceviche or Lil' Lucky. Both boats include top-of-the-line light tackle fishing gear. Their small size is perfect for navigating the shallow back bays and grassy flats of the bay, to catch a variety of species including redfish, speckled trout, Spanish mackerel and flounder. 

- Overview: The huge draw at this aquarium is its various marina animal encounters. You can feed fish and penguins, and get up-close and personal with dolphins, harbor seals, sea lions and sea turtles. You can also snorkel with stingrays and swim with dolphins (age restrictions apply).

- <u>Underwater Museum of Art</u>:



 Location: Grayton Beach State Park, 357 Main Park Rd, Santa Rosa Beach, FL 32459

 Overview: The Underwater Museum of Art's sculpture garden is located in the Gulf of Mexico in Walton County, Florida. The site lies in approximately 58-feet of water and at a distance of less than one nautical mile from shore. Visitors traveling by car can access the museum via <u>Grayton Beach State Park</u> which offers parking, showers, restrooms, changing rooms, and a beach walkover. Visitors who wish to experience the site at-depth should be *certified divers* who are comfortable swimming in open water. The coordinates for the center sculpture (SWARA Skull) are N 30*18.754 W 086*09.562. Out of respect for the art, boaters are asked to find the center location and then move away from the park to anchor in order to avoid damage to the artwork.

<u>Dive30A</u> will offer regular trips directly to the dive site from Grayton Beach. Call 850-460-1442 for more information.

<u>Emerald Coast Scuba</u> in Destin offers regularly scheduled trips to the dive site and can schedule private charters.

- Location: Heritage Park and Cultural Center, 139 Miracle Strip Pkwy SE, Fort Walton Beach, FL 32548

- Overview: Fort Walton Beach. This is an educational and cultural center that aims to preserve, interpret and present the prehistory and history of the Fort Walton Beach community and the Northwest Florida area from 14,000 B.C. through the 1950s. The Center encompasses the Indian Temple Mound Museum, Camp Walton Schoolhouse Museum, Garnier Post Office Museum, Fort Walton Temple Mound and the Civil War Exhibit Building.
