Technology

- **Download the MSC for Me app** This app will be used for cruise check-in and to help you navigate your cruise itinerary. It will also serve as the central hub for both MSC and Love Like You Mean It information this year.
 - (Morgan Eberle will email your MSC Booking Number mid November so you can link your reservation.)
- **Download WhatsApp** This is our primary communication tool onboard for the volunteer team. Please make sure it's installed and that notifications are turned on.

• Internet Access – Each volunteer will receive a one-device internet package to help you stay connected during the cruise. Please note that MSC's Wi-Fi plans are device-specific — once connected, it cannot be transferred to another device. If you wish to use multiple devices, you may upgrade your package at your own expense through our team (you will need to notify Morgan of that request so she can get you in touch with a LLYMI Guest Services teammate to get that package upgraded)

🧳 Packing & Preparation

Helpful Items to Bring

- 1 European outlet converter
- Small personal medicine kit (Dramamine, ibuprofen, Tylenol, Tums, Imodium, cough drops, prescriptions, etc.)
- Motion sickness prevention (patches or wristbands if needed)
- Sunscreen, SPF chapstick, aloe, and lotion
- Downy Wrinkle Release spray (no steamers allowed onboard)
- Travel size Poo-Pourri or air freshener spray (if traveling with your spouse or sharing a cabin with another volunteer, you can thank us later for this tip $\stackrel{\smile}{\rightleftharpoons}$)

Don't Forget the Basics

- Passport
- Toothbrush/toothpaste
- Personal toiletries (shampoo, conditioner, skincare)
- Hair tools if needed (ship dryers are basic)
- Makeup/remover, razor, deodorant, etc.
- Earplugs or sleep aids if you're a light sleeper
- Charging cables, converter plug
- Comfortable shoes for serving
- Jacket or sweater (the ship can get chilly indoors)
